Our grounds staff are on duty Monday to Friday 9.00am to 3.00pm if you require any assistance within the grounds areas.

Office Hours: Tuesday and Friday 9.30am-2.30pm. Wednesday 9.30am -12.30pm

We welcome visitors to our Cemetery, however we do ask you to abide by the regulations as set out below. These regulations have been formulated and are in place for your safety and the safety of others.

- Picking of Roses from the Rose Bushes is an offence as families' have purchased these plants as a Memorial for their loved ones.
- Wooden Crosses and memorials are only permitted on a burial site for a
 Month period from the initial date of burial.
- The removal of Flowers from Graves and Memorial Sites and placing on other sites is totally prohibited. This is an offence and classified as stealing which is punishable by Law.
- Sprinkling of 'Ashes' by members of the public is not permitted at any time.

 This can only take place by the presence of a Staff member. There is an area allotted for this purpose and a small fee will apply. Please ask at the office.
- As this is a Lawn Cemetery there will be no planting of plants of any kind in the Lawn areas.
- Glass Jars or Vases are not permitted to be used as flower containers in Cemetery Grounds.
- Dogs are welcome in the cemetery if they are on a leash only, and all deposits are removed.
- Please ensure that all rubbish is placed in the bins provided.
- Alcohol in the cemetery grounds is strictly prohibited.
